# **EDREMİT**

#### **Edremit History:**

Edremit has been named as Edremit, Gümüşdere and Sarmansuyu since its establishment. The name Edremit is the oldest. The name Sarmansuyu; Inspired by the Shamran channel. The name Edremit is taken from Arabic. "Erd = place, met = long" means.

Van-Edremit and its environs have a long history. 18 km from Van. Although the exact date of establishment of Edremit in close proximity is unknown; Considering the history of Van and the construction date of the Menua (Shamram) channel. It is seen that it dates back to 900th years.

# **Edremit Geography:**


Edremit, Turkey's Lake Van, the largest lake stretches along the southern and southeastern coastline. It is "the green scratch of the blue lake iyle with its greenery. The location of the district follows the coastline. The length of the district center varies between 5 km and 1.5-2 km. The distance of the district to Van is 18 km. The area is 600 km<sup>2</sup>.


Typical continental climate prevails in Edremit, depending on Van. Winters are long, cold and snowy and summers are hot. Edremit Turkey in terms of the number of sunny days is located in the first row. The average number of sunny days is over 200 days per year. With this potential, Edremit will be an important place in renewable energy.

#### **Edremit Population Structure:**

At the end of 2018, according to the address-based population system data, the total population of Edremit was calculated as 125.884 people. After Van became metropolitan, the population of the district increased with the neighborhoods connected to the district.

The officers, teachers and employees working in Van province and the surrounding villages live here. Besides, there are substitutes both in the province and in the district center due to the fact that the town of Edremit is very close to the province of Van. Together with the Toki houses built after the earthquake, the population has also increased. When the Edremit population structure next to the indigenous peoples of the tasks required of people from every corner of

Turkey, we see that stay here. The population of the district increased by 1.2% compared to the previous year.

When we look at the age graph of the district population, 34% are in the 0-14 age group and 29% are in the 15-19 age range.

# **Edremit County Education:**

There are 130 educational institutions in Edremit district center, towns and villages. There are 35,647 students. There are 1,475 classrooms and 1,987 teachers. The number of students per classroom is 31 in primary, 21 in secondary and 28 in vocational and technical education. The district also has a Tourism and Hotel Management High School. Especially, this school opened with the Edremit Tourism potential in mind is very important in terms of meeting the need of qualified personnel in tourism enterprises in the district.

# **Edremit District Economy:**

Edremit district economy is based on agriculture, animal husbandry and most importantly tourism. Agriculture is generally done through fruits and vegetables that can be grown in the district. In recent years, modern fruit cultivation has been worked with the projects. The fact that the number of sunny days of the district is high and the climate is more temperate than the other regions has revealed the potential of covered agriculture in the district.

The most important agricultural products of the district center; wheat, barley, sugar beet, sainfoin and alfalfa. In the villages, sheep farming is carried out as well as ovine breeding.

The biggest source of income of the district is tourism. Tourism potential is high in terms of being on the shores of Lake Van and hosting historical buildings. In addition to small tourism businesses in the district there are large tourist hotels.

There are industrial enterprises in the district. Cement factory, sugar factory, mosaic mill enterprises, cobblestone manufacturing enterprises, marble quarries. The contribution of this to the economy of the district is very high.

# **Agriculture:**

Wheat, barley, sugar beet and fruit products are the leading agricultural products of the district. Especially Edremit apple pear and plum are famous. Walnut sales in the region where it grows walnut makes an important economic contribution. Mostly sold in the domestic market. In addition, under cover agriculture is developing.

In Edremit district, 70 hectares of land is under cover farming. In 2018, a total of 682 tons of vegetables were obtained from under cover agriculture.

In the number of agricultural tools;

- 267 tractors
- 1469 Other tools and machines are available.

The district of Edremit has an important potential both in terms of climate and fertile soils. The use of modern agricultural techniques, more productive use of land, training of producers will increase agricultural yields, which will make a major contribution to Van province economy and district economy.

In recent years, under cover agriculture has developed in the district. The district has a mild climate and potential for renewable energy. The sun, our province ranks first in terms of time in Turkey will achieve high yields using this cover in six agricultural potential.

### **Farming:**

Livestock in the district is made in the villages of the district. The presence of pasture is less than the other districts. In addition to bovine and ovine livestock, beekeeping activities are also observed.

The presence of animals in the district;

- 11,024 cattle
- 81,532 sheep
- 7,430 Goats



There is an average of 15 tons of milk production per year. 110 tons of honey is produced annually in 31 enterprises in the district.

#### **Tourism Potential of Edremit District:**

Edremit is the most developed tourism district of Van. Especially Lake Van has



a great advantage to extend along the coast. It has great potential in terms of summer tourism. It has extensive beaches. In addition, cultural tourism is also rich in wealth. It has important historical sites. Edremit district, which is open to tourism at all times of the year, has made significant efforts to develop summer tourism. Recently it has been home to water sports. The presence of large hotels provides great advantages for tourists coming here.



#### **Summer Tourism:**

Edremit has an average of 5 km This coastline. coastline has swimming beaches areas. and beaches. The water of Lake Van is very clean. There is no hardship in terms of swimming. Edremit, which is developed in terms of summer tourism, has an influx of domestic and foreign tourists especially in summer months. On the weekends, those

coming from the city center and surrounding provinces fill the entire coastline of the district. There are beautiful green areas for picnics. In summer, the number of visitors to the district exceeds 500 thousand. This district provides a great profit for tradesmen.

It would not be wrong to use the expression of a holiday village to the district. There are 4 large hotels in the district. These hotels offer beautiful comfort to local and foreign tourists visiting the district. In the district, tourism enterprises have increased. Municipality-run venues, restaurants, picnic areas integrated with green, serve the holidaymakers in the district.

All the beauty of Lake Van can be explored from this district. Van Lake is not only used as a swimming area. At certain times of the year, water sports competitions, fast marine engine races and sailing races are held. It also hosts surfing enthusiasts. The most mystical side of Lake Van emerges as the sun sets. The setting of the sun creates a unique landscape.



#### **Cultural Tourism:**

Edremit district is also rich in cultural tourism. There are artifacts from ancient civilizations in the district. These historical buildings add a different beauty to the district of Edremit.

#### Dilkaya Mound:

It is stated that this artifact dating from the Urartians has a history of 5000 years. As a result of the investigation of

human bones extracted from this historical monument in Edremit district, it was revealed that the first open brain surgery was performed here.

As a result of the excavations, cemeteries, tools and tools from that age were identified. Excavations yielded two graves. One of the graves measures 2.40 and 4.60. The other is slightly smaller.

#### **Historic Şamran Canal:**

The historical Şamran Canal was built 3000 years ago by the Urartian king Menua to transport water to Gürpınar. 70% of this channel passes through this district. The total length is 51 km. This channel, which was built at the time, became a source of water especially for Edremit gardens.

#### Kız Damı:

This structure, which is also known as Devdamı, is a cave with a height of 10-12 meters. Inside the cave are columns, hearths, a way out from the south and a canal. It is stated that this structure, which was not known by Kim, belongs to the prehistoric period (prehistoric).

Besides these historical monuments, the cuneiform writings about the Church and Menua canal in Edremit Taşkale. These works that shed light on history add a distinct tourism value to Edremit district.
