ERCİŞ DISTRICT REPORT

History of Erciş:

The history of the Lake Van basin, including Erciş, goes back to prehistoric times. Although there is no information about Neolithic settlements in the region, Tilkitepe Mound, Edremit, Kalecik, Dilkaya and Ernis tombs find traces of Chalcolithic settlement. Early Hurri culture (3000 BC) is known to be effective in Dilkaya Mound finds. The first official history of Ercis begins with the Urartians (900-600 BC). It is stated in the Arabic sources that the name of Arciş comes from Argişti, King of Urartu, and that Erciş was founded by Urartians.


Geography of Ercis:


The total area of the district is 2,179 km². The altitude is 1750 m. Located 5 kilometers from Vangölü and 25 meters high, Erciş is 90 kilometers away from Van. There are 2 districts, 12 neighborhoods, 86 villages and 36 hamlets.

The Ercis Plain is one of the largest plains on the shores of Lake Van. The plain was introduced into the wide valleys. The places where the Zilan Stream passes are called un Hatun Çukurovası "and the plain on which Erciş district is located is called ulu Suluova.. There are also many plains and pastures with plenty of grass and water. There is Van city center in the south of Erciş district, Muradiye district and Nakhchivan country border in the east and Ahlat and Adilcevaz districts in the west. The continental climate prevails in the region. Winters are cold and hard, summers are hot and dry.

Population Structure of Erciş:

Erciş district is the 2nd largest district of Van province. The total population of Ercis is 173,313 people. Of the total population, 52% (89,717) were male and 48% (83,596) were female. The population of the district increased relative to the previous year.





Education:

The district is a district with a young population. In this respect, the number of students is also high. Apart from the schools of the Ministry of National Education, it is present in the colleges of the Yüzüncü Yıl University. The district is connected to the Ministry of National Education; There are 225 schools and 1,909 classrooms.

There are 55.133 students in the district. 28% of the total population is students.

There is a college and a faculty of business in the district of Yüzüncü Yıl University. These two schools have an average of two thousand students.

District Tourism:

The district has hosted many civilizations with its historical background. It has rich cultural assets. District tourism potential is high. Local and foreign tourists visit the district every year. There are many places to visit. Among the works belonging to the district; Urartian printing patterns, Urartian period Deliçay Castle and Harbor, Urartu cuneiform inscriptions, an open-air temple, Urartian rock tombs, Zernaki hill settlements are available.

Besides these, there are works that shed light on Turkish history. These include cemeteries, castles, tombs and bridges. Among these important works are Ercis Castle, Akcayuva Village Tomb, Koca Yusuf Pasha Tomb.

Ercis Economy:

Among the districts of Van, it is the most organized and developed district in terms of economy. Commercial life is strong. However, it lacks the medium size industry where natural products such as 'sulfur islen are processed.

Erciş Sugar Factory is the institution that has a say in the economy of the district and makes the biggest contribution to the district. The organization, which has been operating for 26 years, has made great contributions to the district of Erciş in economic terms and has had a share in the employment of local people. However, the institution was included in the scope of privatization in 2008. The Company's approximate production capacity is 45 million TL. This is an important contribution to the district and the region is to show.

It has developed in commercial activities in Erciş, where the historical Silk Road passes. There are large and small industrial enterprises in the district. The enterprises that make a great contribution to the district provide employment to the local people. In the district where the Chamber of Commerce

and Industry is located, the activities for opening the Organized Industrial Zone (OIZ) are continuing.

Due to its geological structure, Van province hosts important perlite and pumice deposits. Pumice and perlite deposits are concentrated especially in Erciş district. There are perlite and pumice deposits in Kocapınar and Erbeyli fields in this district. Pumice # 2 in reserves in the world at 6.5% of the total reserves are extracted in Van province in Turkey. Erciş ranks first in pomza and perlite mineral reserves.



Farming:


